



## FAMILY CAMPGROUND

### Campground Rules and Regulations

**CHECK IN** All vehicles are to stop at the store to check in and pay for their camping before proceeding to their campsite. **Check-in** time is after **2:00 pm** (all guests must register before 9pm). **CHECK OUT** time is **12:00 pm**. Please be considerate of fellow campers and arrive earlier to set up your campsite. The noise created from setting up is often disturbing to other campers. Campsite holders must be at least 18 years of age. The holder is responsible for the conduct and behaviour of their family and guests.

#### STORE HOURS

May/June & Sept/Oct: SUN-MON 9AM-2PM, TUE-WED CLOSED, THUR-FRI-SAT 9AM-5PM

July/Aug: MON-TUE-WED 9AM-12PM, THUR-FRI-SAT-SUN 9AM-5PM.

\*\*If Store is closed contact the HOST by calling the campground # 613-478-6844 from 9am to 9pm.

**POSTED SIGNS** Drivers must obey the posted speed limits, signs and be aware of pedestrians, especially children at all times.

**QUIET TIME** is from 11:00 pm to 8:00 am. All electronic devices are to be turned off during quiet hours so as not to disturb other campers.

**RECYCLING** Please utilize proper recycling bins located at the main Washrooms.

**GARBAGE** Garbage must be placed in Clear Plastic Bags. Garbage Box located beside Pump Out Station. If garbage is not in a clear bag we cannot take it to the dump. The dump is now charging a \$1.50 fee per standard clear garbage bag. Please put your \$1.50 in the box provided. Please help us by putting trash where it belongs and do not burn garbage.

**BEACH** and swimming areas are unsupervised. Use at your own risk.

**CHILDREN** Parents and Guardians are responsible for the actions and safety of their children. Children under the age of 18 must be at their campsite by 10pm unless accompanied by an adult. Children are not allowed in washrooms or showers unless accompanied by an adult.

**PETS** must be on a leash not exceeding 2 meters (6 feet) and must be under control at all times. Pets are not to make excessive noise or disturb other persons and are not permitted in the beach area. Swim area for dogs is located between Site 51 & 52. Poop and scoop applies at all times.

**BEHAVIOUR** Rowdy behavior, excessive noise or swearing will not be tolerated. Campers are expected to exercise responsible behaviour at all times. Please respect the property of others; do not cut through or trespass on other people's sites, even when they are not there. Do not take things off of other sites.

**FIREWORKS** are prohibited except by campground staff for specific designated Holidays.

**INJURY/DAMAGE** We assume no responsibility whatsoever for personal injury or loss/damage to vehicles or personal property of any kind.

**RIVER** No washing with shampoos in the river. Do not throw garbage or other items in the river. Help to keep the water clean.

**CAMPFIRES** must be completely extinguished before retiring for the evening. Do not leave fires unattended. Do not burn garbage or leave garbage in the fire pits. Fire pits are placed in an area that should work for your site. This will damage the property if moved. Campfires are only allowed in the fire pits provided at each campsite and only to a maximum of 0.6 meters (2 feet) in height.

**OUTHOUSES** Do not put anything other than the provided biodegradable tissue paper down the outhouse toilets. If you don't put it down your toilet don't put it down the outhouse toilets.

**SMOKING** is not permitted in the following areas as per Ontario law: Rental Units, rented Canoes/Kayaks/Tubes, rented Trailers, Buildings or within 20 ft. of building doorway, Pavilion or within 20 ft. of or on the Beach.

**ALCOHOL** is restricted to your campsite. All illegal substances are prohibited in campground.

**WASHROOMS/SHOWERS** are for your convenience. .25c Showers. Do not remove anything from them. Advise staff if something is out or any problems. No washing of dishes is permitted in the sinks or showers. Outside tap is available to get water from only. \*Children are not allowed in washrooms or showers unless accompanied by an adult.

**LAUNDRY** located in Washroom building. \$2.75 Washer / \$2.25 Dryer (Loonies and Quarters accepted)

**NO WASHING** of vehicles and no running sprinklers or watering grass. Cleaning of your TRAILERS is ENCOURAGED to maintain cleanliness and part of our Park Improvement Plan.

**CAMPSITES** A maximum of 6 persons are permitted overnight per campsite (only 4 being Adults), unless it is a single family of parents and their children living at the same address. Where space permits, a maximum of 3 pieces of shelter equipment is allowed per campsite (ie. sleeping tent and/or screened tent). Only one of which may be a travel trailer, tent trailer, camper van, motor home or self-propelled camping unit.

**ADDITIONAL VEHICLES** 2 vehicles are allowed to park on your site. A vehicle includes a utility trailer or boat trailer. All other vehicles must park in the Visitor Parking area. The number of additional vehicles permitted per campsite may be limited by the staff.

**VISITORS** All visitors to the campground must purchase a Day or Overnight Visitor Pass. Visitors vehicles must be parked in the Visitor parking area. No visitors are allowed to enter the campground after 9:00 pm. Please advise the gate staff if you are expecting any visitors. A visitor can only drive in to the park if you have 1 or less vehicles on your site and if they have paid the fee or you have purchased a seasonal visitor pass. If you have pass you may greet them at the gate to let them in. Otherwise all guests must Park and Walk in.

- Day Visitors fee \$5 per person (or car load for \$10) must leave the campground by 9:00 pm.
- Overnight visitors must pay "Overnight Guest" fee \$10 per person. Must leave the campground by 12pm the next day or pay an additional Day Visitor fee of \$5.
- Seasonal campers may purchase a Seasonal Visitor Pass for \$150. which allows visitors to their site at no charge to the visitor - Day and/or Night. Seasonal visitors pass is non-transferrable. Grandchildren, 17 and under are free to stay, 18 and over Visitor rates apply. Campsites rules still apply.

**FIREWOOD** Please help us protect our forests **DO NOT TRANSPORT FIREWOOD**, it is illegal. Moving firewood, even just a few kilometers away, can spread invasive and destructive insect species such as the Emerald Ash Borer and Asian long-horned beetle to our forests. You could face penalties of up to \$50,000 and/or prosecution if you move firewood. You can find more info on this topic at [www.inspection.gc.ca](http://www.inspection.gc.ca). Firewood is available to purchase at store. \$8.50 Bundle or \$25.00 for 5 bundles. Any remaining firewood should not leave the campground. No cutting or damaging trees for firewood.

**RESERVATIONS** Multiple reservations in the same name for the same time period are discouraged. Reservations should be made in the name of the person who is arriving and staying on campsite. Reservations cannot be assigned from one person to another at the time of arrival. If a name change is required contact 613-478-6844. Only the person named on the permit shall make those changes. The site shall not be occupied until the changes are made. Full payment of camping fees are payable at the time of arrival. Payment must be made by credit card, debit, or cash. A 3 night minimum payment is required on Holiday Long Weekends. A "no-show" is a reservation that has not been claimed by 2:00 pm the day following the arrival date. A "no-show" will result in the reservation being cancelled and the campsite will become available to a new camper.

**CANCELLATIONS/CHANGES** Reservation/Change/Cancellation Fees are Non-Refundable. When canceling prior to departure time, NO CASH refunds are provided under any circumstances at the campground. Refunds will only be issued if reservation is cancelled before 30 days. Campers evicted from the campground for any circumstance are not eligible for reimbursement. Camping is an outdoor experience. Therefore, no reimbursement will be approved for discomforts of nature including rain, snow, temperature change and insects.

**PICNIC SHELTER** The Pavilion may be booked through the office throughout the year or at the park during the operating season. Pavilion may be booked from 9:00 am to 9:00 pm (hours may be extended for special events such as weddings which may incur additional fees. No liquor will be sold without proper licenses at your expense). The rental fee for the Picnic Shelter is \$100.00 plus HST. Payment must be made prior to confirmation of reservation. Pavilion area offers one Picnic shelter which accommodates 75 persons with picnic tables, water and washrooms close by. Garbage receptacles are provided and renters shall leave the facility in a clean and sanitary condition at the end of the day. If the Facility is left unkempt, a \$50.00 fee will be applied. Pets are allowed at the Picnic Shelters, but must be under control at all times and must be on a leash not exceeding 2 meters (6 feet).

**GROUP CAMPING/YOUTH GROUPS** Reservations can be made by contacting Office 613-478-6844. Youth Group camping refers to non-profit, charitable, adult supervised youth groups generally with youth under 18 years of age. Adult supervision (must be 18 or over). Should not be less than 1 adult for each 10 youth, e.g. Boy Scouts, Girl Guides. Group camping refers to an organized group of families or organized club consisting of adults or adults and children who wish to reserve as a group in the non-serviced campgrounds. Minimum of 4 camping units required for a reservation (1 camping unit is defined as a maximum of 6 people) to qualify for the Group Rates. \$5.00 Adult & \$1 Child under 14.

**SEASONAL SITES** are for the use of the original purchaser and eligible family members only. You, your spouse, children and grandchildren under 18 are eligible family members. Applicable rates will apply to all other guests regardless of age.

**CLEANLINESS** This means that for Seasonal's nothing is stored on the grass or under your trailer - such as tools, supplies or unsightly items. Campsites and campground must be kept clean and tidy at all times. If site is left unkempt and not cleared of debris an eviction notice will be sent out.

**NO SUBLETTING** is permitted. Use by other persons will only be allowed by making prior arrangements with staff and regular camping rates will apply.

**DECKS** can be 10' wide, and as long as the Trailer is, excluding the hitch. It MUST be approved by owner prior to the onset of any work.

**NO APPLIANCES** will be seen outside. Fridges or freezers need to be kept in a shed or in your trailer at all times.

**SATELLITE DISHES** are not to be attached to any trees. ONLY 1 Satellite dish per site is permitted. Must be within your site boundaries and NOT located within 15' from River side. Please notify management of location before mounting. Height Restriction: maximum 5'6", unless mounted to the top of your trailer which can only be 24".

**CLOTHES LINES** are NOT permitted. Nothing shall be attached to ANY tree or campground posts. Portable clothing racks can be used. This is a liability and hazard.

**GRASS CUTTING** is the responsibility of the occupant. If grass is not kept mowed ONCE A WEEK, staff will cut at a cost of \$15 per time. You can purchase a \$65. Seasonal Lawn Care fee. Please make arrangements before the camping season starts if you will not be here until later than May long weekend, when grass cutting starts. No gas lawnmowers.

**SHEDS** are permitted at a maximum of 1 per site at a maximum size of 64 sq.ft. These sheds MUST be plastic or tin/steel. No wooden structures permitted.

**NO WOODEN STRUCTURES**, lean-tos or add a rooms to be erected.

**FIRE PIT** if you wish to put in a new fire pit this MUST first be approved by staff.

**ELECTRIC OUTLET** You are provided with one electrical outlet and one water outlet. At the end of the season any splitters must be removed from taps. If left on they will be removed by staff and discarded.

**TREES / NO CUTTING** damaging or removing any branches or trees to make more space (for a trailer or shed or for any other reason). You will be held responsible for all damages. Absolutely NO leaning items of any sort on a tree.

**ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES** are not permitted to be driven within the campground or driven in and out of the campground excessively (no joy riding). You may store them on a trailer on your site, if you have not exceeded your vehicle per site vehicle limit.

**TRAILER FOR SALE** In the event of a sale of your trailer or early departure from the park site fees are non-transferable and non-refundable. If your trailer is sold in the park a 10% commission fee is applicable plus HST. As part of our Park Improvement Plan trailers 20 years or older in our park WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO BE SOLD HERE or remain here after you're finished using (no transferring/handing down to family or friends). No trailers will be sold without the campground owners consent. New seasonal occupants must have a trailer that is less than 20 years old. Any present occupant that wishes to upgrade must also comply with the 20 yr. rule.

**CHAINSAWS** are prohibited in the campground.

**NO GAS POWERED** equipment of any kind. This also means no storage of gasoline or other hazardous materials.

**GENERATORS** are prohibited in the campground.

**WEAPONS** Sling shots, air guns, guns, or bows or other types of weapons are forbidden.

**INSURANCE** All Seasonal Sites must have RV Insurance in able to park their trailer in the park. Without this you will NOT be granted Occupancy.

**SEWAGE** from portable toilets or trailers holding tanks must be emptied at the dumping station in the disposal tank ONLY, not in washroom toilets or outhouses or on the ground. No sewage will be dumped into grey water barrels. Management will carry out inspection at random. Clean-up of found sewage will be at the renter's expense. Pump outs are available at a cost of \$30.00 per time/\$200. for the Season, (10x) Thursdays Bi-weekly. If you exceed the 10 pump outs it will then be \$30 each time.

**CAMPGROUND IS CLOSED** from 9pm to 9am. No one will have access in during these hours unless you have a gate card. For the SEASON it is closed Thanksgiving Monday at 4pm until the May Long Weekend at 12pm. No trailers will be removed or pulled into a campsite between these times.

At no time will anyone enter the premises for any reason. This is not only for our peace of mind, but it is a property liability. This is also the park's time for cleanup, repair and construction at which time no one is allowed on the grounds.

*The management reserves the right to refuse or evict any camper. Please obey the Campground Rules & Regulations posted.*

*Violations may result in you being asked to leave the park without any recourse.*
